

In Norway students can use PCs in the classroom while in Italy it is forbidden.




Norwegians can eat or drink during lessons if they ask permission while Italians aren't allowed to.

- In Norway and in Italy the students are free to dress up as they want but they tend to use a casual style.






PERSONAL BOOKLET
