

Alesund University College: REPORT

-Location

Ålesund University College is located in Ålesund and organizes courses to form staff for the local industry. The candidates' needs and the demands of the local market are a vital part of the study programmes.

-Main aim

The University College's main aim is to educate the students for the local industry.

-Specialisation

marine studies, engineering, nursing studies and business/marketing. The Ålesund University College founded in 1994 merged together 3 different institutes.

-Some trivia concerning the students

Classes

Every student has an average of 20-25 hours of tuition every week, but the students are not obliged to attend classes. Although, some lectures and exercises are mandatory.

Exams

There are two exam periods. One is in May, and the other is in December. Normally, a student will have 2-5 exams every semester, depending on which courses they attend.

Fees

If you are going to study at Ålesund University College, you only have to pay a small fee of about 1000 Norwegian Crowns. This is just to be registered at the school and to cover exam expenses.

Economic support

If a student needs money, he can apply for a scholarship/loan. If the student finishes his studies and completes his exams, 40% of his loan will turn into a scholarship which he won't have to pay down.

A student can receive about 90 000 Norwegian Crowns as economic support every year.

Switching study programmes

If a student decides to abandon his current studies for new ones, he can skip the subjects which he has already dealt with.

The «hottest» study programme!

In the last few years, nautical studies have been the hottest programme. Engineering is also popular.

-Administration

General administration covers economic regulations while the staff devoted to "student support" supply the students with answers for practical and professional questions.

-Cooperation

Ålesund University College cooperates a lot with local corporations. The steady dialogue with the local companies is a good way to get to know the educational needs of the youth and the demands of the local market. Students are asked to work on research projects with these corporations, both at school and at their facilities.

-Career guidance

There is no specific career guidance at Ålesund University College even though students of engineering are put in touch with local companies to experience how it will be like working with these companies and within this branch. The University College also informs about job opportunities.
